Twentieth Century Society

An age with automatic washing machines in the home and laundrettes at the street corner, has little use for washing greens. The Welfare State, rising after countless philanthropic and charitable causes has grown to overshadow them. What function then in present day Glasgow has the North Parish Washing Green Society?

To justify the Society's continuance, we can do little better than reprint, with minor amendments, the history written for an earlier booklet by our former preses, the late Mr. J. Arnold Fleming some thirty years ago. To that history we add a Roll of all who became members during the first sixty-seven years of the twentieth century. Many of these are no longer with us. Few are still to be found at the addresses given. The list is nevertheless of great interest. The Society is a piece of Old Glasgow, serving a useful function in the twentieth century. And many new readers, seeing the name of a father, uncle, or former colleague on our Roll, will wish to add their personal support to the "Washing Green".

Living History in Glasgow

The title of this old Society has a quaint, unfamiliar and distinctive ring about it to modern ears, accustomed to many charities, but none so mundane as to concern themselves with a washing-green. Nevertheless, the name enshrines in its present survival an interesting page of social history of a bygone, semi-rural Glasgow when it was a comparatively small community, as yet clean and unspoilt by the clouds of smoke from industry. It also carries our memories back to those days when the Cross was the centre of civic life. The renowned red-cloaked proud Tobacco Lords taking their daily stroll along the plainstones before the Tontine in the Trongate were of but recent occurrence when this Society was established.

Beyond Buchanan Street there was nothing but green fields. From the Saltmarket to the Cathedral ran the High Street up the Bell o' the Brae, and fronting this thoroughfare was situated then our venerable University. In those more leisurely days it took twelve hours to travel to Edinburgh!

The Molendinar Burn

The Heritors of the North Quarter in April, 1792, decided to equip and manage washing-greens on ground which they owned beside the banks of this, then clear and open stream flowing freely to the Clyde; the free income of which was to be distributed among the poor of the North Parish. The Directors drew up certain rules and regulations for "wigs on the green" had to be firmly, if tactfully dealt with, and so the Magistrates of the Town Council of Glasgow granted a Seal of Cause in 1793. The Charter chest containing this precious document still exists. The Board, composed of representative citizens, has ever consisted of a Preses, Treasurer and Clerk, with eight others duly elected at the Annual Meeting held in December. These meetings were originally held in the "Penny" North Parish School, but in 1850 the Lord Provost granted permission for them to be held in the Session House of our Cathedral when desired.

The Seal of Cause

The Seal of Cause states, "The proprietors and inhabitants of the said Parish shall give intimation to the tacksman the day before they are to wash of their intention to do so, in which case the tacksman shall be obliged to keep room for them in preference to any others, and if any difference shall arise between the tacksman and the persons resorting to the said washing-green, either about any such preference or about the rates specified in the authorised table, the same shall be referred to the Preses, Treasurer and the Directors of the Society.

"The tacksman shall personally attend the Green in order that the women may at all times find it clean, the water warm, the House in order, and its tubs, stools, etc., ready for use and shall not hinder the washer-women taking water from Nannie's Well. He is not to sell ale or spirits."

An inventory of those days shows that the utensils were:—"130 boynes, 10 tubs, 18 pails, 79 stools, tresses and ropes and pins, 2 hot-water boilers and 2 barrows."

The Town's Bellman proclaimed as each 28th October came round:—"The extensive and commodious North Parish Green, together with the wash and dwelling house, tubs, stools and other utensils belonging thereto, are to be let by public roup, within the house of Matthew Salmond, Vintner, Kirk Lane, opposite the High Kirk upon Thursday next, at twelve o'clock noon for the ensuing year."

Pollution of the Burn

During 1803 serious complaints arose regarding the steeping of lint, in preparation for the weaving of linen, in Hogganfield Loch causing the Molendinar Burn to be unfit for washing in, and so the Sheriff issued an order in favour of the Society, who now erected a dam across the stream to render it more serviceable. The problem of obtaining clean water was of grave concern then, the successful sinking of the Barrel Well was of vital importance as it yielded a copious supply until the introduction of the Loch Katrine source through the able skill of Dr. Cleland and the engineer, Mr. Alston.

State of the Funds

With such minor interruptions the Society, like the Molendinar rippled gently along for its first eighty years. Its pastoral activities can be assessed by this Abstract of the Funds prepared on the occasion of a by-gone General Meeting:

Besides the Society's Heritable Property, consisting of about two acres and-a-half of Ground, with Dwelling House, Washing House, and other buildings thereon.

Sale of the Washing Greens

When the Merchants' House began to lay out the Necropolis and throw a bridge across the Molendinar and incidentally across the washing-greens, the Society elected Mr. Milne, the overseer, one of its Directors, thus ensuring a friendly interest in their rights. But by the year 1873 the greens, becoming unsuitable for their original purpose, were sold to the Royal Infirmary for the sum of £3,005. Thus was brought to a close the first eighty years of the Society's existence, but it has continued ever since fulfilling its merciful mission as a Trust, the claims of the needy having never been denied so far as means allowed. And so a portion of Old Glasgow has been transformed into practical service in the bustling life of these modern days. Yet the memory of the quondam washing-greens survives; this Society is its monument.

A Useful Charity

From its foundation it has been fortunate in receiving the support of members of our Corporation, the Trades House, the Merchants' House, Chamber of Commerce, and other public bodies. Principal Macfarlan, of the Old College, was from its inception one of its most leal friends in assisting the higher education of any poor "lad o' pairts". As winter approached the pupils of the washerwomen attending the "Penny" Lennox School, once situated beyond the old Barony Kirk and at the present entrance to the Necropolis, were provided with boots and stockings. Nor were the mothers overlooked, for they enjoyed an excursion as each month of May came round. Many graphic

tales might be recounted regarding past and present beneficiaries. We may picture how these douce housewives for three-quarters of a century exchanged over the washtub the gossip which their spouses gathered in the coffee-houses around the Tolbooth.

The progress of Glasgow's prosperity reads like a romance, but in our pride of achievement let us never forget our obligations. This duty our Society has always kept before it. Comforts are still required—the amount we are able to grant appears very small—yet it means much to those of limited resources.

Life Membership

Payment of One Guinea has from the beginning constituted Life Membership. Through such payments, together with generous donations and legacies, a sum has been accumulated, which, being added to the price the Green fetched when disposed of, makes a present capital of £17,000 invested in trust funds. Within its scope the work is carried on gratuitously, so that, excepting incidental outlays, the entire revenue is distributed monthly among some forty deserving recipients born in or long associated with the neighbourhood of the North Parish around our ancient Cathedral. For their well-being the Society is still active.

Regulations and By-laws

I.

The Society shall be known by the name of the "NORTH PARISH WASHING-GREEN SOCIETY."

II.

The Society shall have for its object the relief of deserving persons born or long resident in the North Parish of Glasgow.

III.

All Contributors of £1 1s. each shall be enrolled as Members of the Society.

IV.

All Entry Money, Subscriptions and Donations, as also the Net Surplus Funds that may not have been required for the relief of pensioners, whenever and as often as such surplus funds have accumulated to an amount of not less than £100 sterling, shall be added to, and form part of, the Capital Account of the Society, and are to be invested in duly recognised Trust Securities. The Directors shall cause any surplus funds in the hands of the Treasurer to be deposited in Bank.

V.

The Society shall be governed and directed by a Board, consisting of Preses and Treasurer elected from among the Directors of the preceding year, with eight other Directors appointed at the Annual Meeting of members of the Society. Of these eight, two shall retire annually by rotation of tenure of office from the time of their respective previous elections, but shall be eligible for re-election.

In event of a vacancy occurring in the Directorate, the Directors shall elect another or others to fill such vacancy or vacancies till next Annual Election without calling a General Meeting of the Society for the purpose.

VI.

The Preses or Chairman of the Meetings shall have in all cases, and at all Meetings of the Society and of the Directors a deliberative, and, in cases of equality, a casting vote.

Should the Preses be absent at the time fixed for any Meeting, the members present shall choose one of their number to act as Chairman, with the same powers as the Preses of the Society.

VII.

The Directors, of whom three shall be a quorum, shall hold at least two Meetings in the year, to be held in the Office of the Clerk, or in such other place as the Preses shall appoint for the general business of
